The winery is located in the hills of Treiso, a small village in the province of Cuneo, and produces the traditional wines of the area: Langhe Nebbiolo, Barbaresco, Dolcetto d'Alba, and Langhe Arneis.

The cultivation of the vineyards has always been carried out with a deep respect for nature, using the best low-impact technologies to minimize environmental harm. They are also certified under the SQNPI (National Quality System of Integrated Production), a production method that ensures the quality of our products exceeds commercial standards.

This Dolcetto d'Alba highlights the charm of the Piedmont region's beloved variety. It has a vibrant ruby red color and an inviting nose, offering a fragrant bouquet of ripe plum, light peach, and subtle almond.

On the palate, the wine is smooth and well-balanced, with soft tannins and a harmonious structure that makes it easy to enjoy. A classic example of Dolcetto, it perfectly captures the fruit-forward character and balance that define the style.
