

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Pascale Rion Côte-de-Nuits Villages « Mosaic » :



The Rion family has cultivated vines in Burgundy for several generations, passing downs expertise and a deep respect for the land. The estate's oldest vines come from a selection made by Louis Rion, grandfather of the current grower. Today, the family legacy continues with renewed energy and a commitment to quality. Thus, the 2022 vintage marks the beginning of a new era for this 4.3 hectares estate, now fully managed by the next generation. Precision viticulture and a deep respect for terroir drive the work from vine to bottle.

The Côte de Nuits-Villages appellation offers a window into Burgundy's intricate vineyard heritage, where each parcel is shaped by nature and refined by human hands. While most of the Côte de Nuits-Villages wines are labeled under the broader AOC rather than by individual "climat" name, they are often produced from sites that possess genuine character and historical relevance.

The best plots are typically located on mid-slope terraces with soils of limestone and marl over clay, offering good drainage and excellent ripening conditions for Pinot Noir. These vineyards yield wines that reflect the broader identity of the Côte de Nuits: aromatic precision, mineral tension, and earthy depth, but with a more approachable profile, making them excellent ambassadors of Burgundy's terroir without the exclusivity of the Grand and Premier Crus.
