

Pascale Rion Nuits-Saint -Georges 1er Cru « Aux vignerondes »





Nuits-Saint-Georges lies at the southern gateway to the Côte de Nuits and gives its name to one of Burgundy's most historic appellations While known for producing structured and age-worthy wines, the identity of Nuits-Saint-Georges is deeply tied to its "climats", a unique Burgundian system of vineyard classification that reflects centuries of observation, viticultural refinement, and geological understanding. A "climat" in Burgundy is not simply a vineyard, it is a precisely delineated plot of land whose character has been shaped by its natural conditions (soil, slope, orientation, microclimate) and by generations of human cultivation.

The Premier Cru "Aux Vignerondes » is one these climats. Located in the northern part of Nuits-Saint-Georges, close to the boundary with Vosne-Romanée, it benefits from an east-facing mid-slope position, where vines are planted on shallow, well-drained soils composed of limestone, clay, and small stones. Due to its position and soil profile, the "Aux Vignerondes climat" produces wines that combine the structural depth typical of Nuits-Saint-George with an added layer of finesse and aromatic precision, reminiscent of its northern neighbors.

Pascale Rion and her family proudly perpetuate this fantastic heritage to offer exceptional wines that truly express their origin. Committed to responsible, sustainable farming, they carefully manage the vineyard to respect the land and enhance the unique qualities of the "Aux Vignerondes climat". Their dedication ensures each bottle reflects both the richness of the terroir and a thoughtful, reasoned approach to viticulture.
